



American Association of University Professors – Collective Bargaining Congress Certification of Qualification for AAUP-CBC Service under LMRDA

The federal Labor-Management Reporting and Disclosure Act (LMRDA) prohibits individuals who have been convicted of certain crimes from holding office or employment in labor organizations. Because AAUP-CBC complies with the LMRDA, we are obligated to use good faith efforts to ensure that no disqualified persons serve AAUP-CBC as employees or leaders. You are ineligible to serve on the AAUP-CBC Executive Committee, Audit Committee, Investment Committee, or staff if you have been convicted of, or imprisoned for, any of the following crimes during the past thirteen (13) years:

Any felony involving abuse or misuse of my position or employment in a labor organization or employee benefit plan to seek or obtain an illegal gain at the expense of the labor organization's members or the beneficiaries of the employee benefit plan;

Violations of Title II or Title III of the LMRDA, including: knowingly making a false statement of material fact or failing to disclose a material fact in a report required by the LMRDA; willfully failing to file a required report; willfully violating the LMRDA's recordkeeping requirements; willfully making a false entry in labor organization records or other documents required to be kept by the LMRDA or willfully concealing, withholding or destroying such records; willfully and improperly transferring funds from a trustees local to the parent body imposing the trusteeship; or willfully counting the votes of delegates from a trustees local under certain circumstances;

Embezzlement, bribery, extortion, burglary, robbery, grand larceny, narcotics violations, rape, arson, assault with intent to kill, assault that inflicts grievous bodily injury, or murder;

Conspiracy to commit, or attempting to commit, any of the above crimes;

Any crime in which any of the above crimes is an element; or

Any crime equivalent to the above crimes. For example, obtaining money by false pretenses can, in certain cases, be equivalent to grand larceny.
